GOLF DRESS CODE

(Golf course, Putting green and all practice areas, including golf lessons and golf classes)

- Men must wear slacks or Bermuda length shorts. Women must wear slacks, capris, golf shorts, skirts, skorts or dresses.
- Only shirts with sleeves and collars are allowed for men. Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts at all times. Turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks are acceptable.
- Shirts with sleeves and collars are preferred for women; however women may wear a round collarless shirt with sleeves or a shirt with a collar and no sleeves. No women's clothing is allowed where the midriff is visible
- Only spikeless shoes are permitted on the golf course and practice facilities. Spikeless shoes include soft spikes, golf shoes with rubber treads, and sneakers.
- Caps must be worn with bill forward at all times. Men and boys must remove hats in any dining areas inside the clubhouse.
- 6. At no time are jeans, denim, or cargo clothing, cutoff shorts, sweat shorts/jersey shorts/sport shorts, jogging/sweat/warm up or yoga pants, T-shirts/tank tops/mesh shirts/athletic shirts/sweat shirts or any undergarment type attire with or without printed slogan, strapless tops/halter tops or tube tops, any camouflage attire or shoes with metal spikes/high top sneakers/water footwear allowed anywhere on the golf course and practice facilities.

CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

(All dining areas in the clubhouse including the Bar, Vista Room, Terrace Room and Back Patio, Front Patio and Junior Pavilion)

Between the hours of 6am and 6pm, Golf course attire is enforced in ALL Clubhouse dining areas.

Beginning at 6PM Sunday-Thursday:

- 1. Casual attire will be permitted in all dining areas.
- Casual attire includes jeans/denim, untucked collared shirts, cargo shorts or pants, halter/tank tops for women and sandals.
- 3. Only shirts with sleeves and collars for men. Turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks are acceptable.
- 4. Casual attire does not include bathing suits, cutoff shorts, sweat shorts or pants, jersey shorts/sport shorts, jogging/sweat/warm up or yoga pants, mesh shirts/athletic shirts, any undergarment type attire with or without printed slogan, or water shoes. No women's clothing is allowed where the midriff is visible.

Beginning 6PM Friday and Saturday:

- The Vista Room dining dress code will follow GOLF COURSE dress code with the exception of women being permitted to wear halter/tank tops. Jackets are not required for men at any time.
- 2. Casual attire will be permitted in the Terrace Room, Back Patio, Front Patio and Bar area ONLY.

Parent/caregiver/nanny Junior Pick Up DRESS CODE:

- 1. Casual Attire is acceptable in all parking lots while picking up children.
- However, any adults planning on watching on the Golf Course or entering any Clubhouse dining areas during the hours of 6AM-6PM must adhere to the Golf Course dress code stated above.
